Note: A mini theatrette and an in-house climbing structure called the Wallholla have also been provisioned for this area and these are built-in.

SECTION A: EDUCATIONAL PLAY

o Marble Machine by The Tinkering Studio (Wall mounted)

The Marble Machine located at the Spore Science Centre allows a child to direct a path of marbles through peg, tracks and bells building endless during plays. We are collaborating with the Science Centre on the build and facilitation of the Marble machine.



o Lego wall and Lego tables (2 tables)

This is a classic space for kids of all ages to enjoy. We are working with Lego education to offer add-ons including Lego robotic classes.



o Imagination Playground (Blocks)

Large modular blocks for children to expand their creativity



SECTION B: TECHNOLOGY

o Gaming (4 units)

Prior to the migration to the temporary spaces, the Zone comprised of 36 gaming units including PCs, Wii, Xboxes, Playstation and Arcade games. The team received constant feedback across the years from parents to reduce the numbers as gaming is now readily available on most electronic devices as well as home computers. The footprint of gaming units available was downsized to by 62% to 14 units at its current site and will reduce to 13 units at the new space.
